



Inshore Lifeboat, at 3.01pm on 5 February 2020

Swanage's Inshore Lifeboat (ILB) was requested to launch this afternoon after the UK Coastguard received a '999' call from a person stating that they were cut off by the tide at Old Harry Rocks.

The lifeboat crew were paged and the ILB launched to assist.

As the lifeboat approached the scene a radio message was received from the Coastguard saying that the person had been recovered safe and well by an RNLI Atlantic 85 class lifeboat that was training in the area. With this new information received the Swanage volunteers were stood down and returned to station.



This year, Swanage's lifeboats have responded to one incident together.

The Shannon class all-weather lifeboat has not yet launched to any other incidents.

The D class inshore lifeboat has launched to one other service.

This gives a total of 2 incidents responded to, so far, this year
