



Inshore Lifeboat, at 12.07pm on 14 January 2019

The first service call of 2019 for the inshore lifeboat (ILB) was received just before midday today, Monday 14 January. An immediate launch of the ILB was requested following reports of a person in the water at Peveril Point.

The lifeboat crew were paged and were ready to launch 9 minutes later. However, as the lifeboat was being lowered down the slipway it became apparent that the person had managed to recover themselves. The lifeboat crew stood by at the water's edge until it was confirmed that the situation was resolved. The lifeboat was then recovered back to the boathouse and the volunteers went back to work.



This year, Swanage's lifeboats have not yet responded to any incidents together.

The Shannon class all-weather lifeboat has launched to 1 incident.

The D class inshore lifeboat has also responded to 1 incident.

This gives a total of 2 incidents, so far, this year
